The duly completed quotation marked "**REF No & Closing date**" on the top left hand corner of the envelop should be sent under registered cover to reach the **Principal Investigator of NRC Grant 17-037, Prof. Tilak Hewawasam, Department of Geography, Faculty of Arts, University of Peradeniya, Peradeniya KY 20400, Sri Lanka** on or before **1.30 p.m. on 28/02/2018**. **Bid opening will be at 3.30 p.m. on 28/02/2018** at the Assistant Registrar Office of the Faculty of Arts, University of Peradeniya. The list of items is attached in the enclosure. In case of international bidders please submit your proposal in paper with Letter of Credit and international warranty details. International bidders can join bid opening via SKYPE with a prior arrangement. The decision of the NRC Tender Board shall be final. Please enclose following details together with your quotation.

Terms and Conditions;

1. Quotation **validity period** should be **90 days**.
2. Submit your **VAT** Registration details.
3. Please indicate the **taxes** separately.
4. **NBT will not paid** by National Research Council.
5. NRC grant **reference number** should be mentioned in all relevant documents, if not the quotations can be rejected.
6. All items should be provided to above address in good condition.
7. You will be able to provide an **installation and commissioning certificate** along with the invoice.
8. If equipment value Rs. 5,000,000/- or more, should provide **contract certificate** from **Samagam Medura**.
9. Please fill this form and submit with an original quotation.
10. All catalogues and other necessary details should be provided along with the quotation. When the specifications are not mentioned in catalogues, supplier should provide a letter of confirmation from manufacturer that the specifications required, could be provided.
11. A letter of confirmation and authorization for post sales period should be submitted along with the quotation.

12. You should provide a **10 % bank guarantee** with the **validity period of 45 days**, written in favor of "**Chairman/National Research Council**". The validity period starts from the date on which the supplier receives the purchase order. (For **equipment more than Rs. 500,000/-**)

International bidders please note

14. When equipment/consumables amounting to more than SLRs. 1 Mn (approximately above US \$ 6650) are to be imported directly from the principals, a Letter of Credit (L/C) should be opened. For equipment/consumables less than SLRs. 1 Mn, Telegraphic Transfer (T/T) could be opened on the approved Performa Invoice. US \$1 = SLR 155.00. Please clearly indicate warranty arrangements and freight/insurance charges in the bidding document.
